E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed to the motion say nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1099, Mr. President. No Enrollment and Review. Senator Johnson would move to amend, AM3093. (Legislative Journal page 1157.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Johnson, to open on AM3093 to LB 1099. Senator Johnson. Is Senator Johnson on the floor? Senator Johnson, you're recognized to open on your amendment to LB 1099.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. President. This bill was introduced at the request of the Secretary of State's Office. And basically what it was, with the original bill, was to change the fees, many of which had been in existence for 20 or more years. The stakeholders and the Secretary of State's Office had agreed on the different filing fees, and all parties were agreed on that, and this passed unanimously. Subsequent to that, there has been a review of these fees, and it has been determined that on one fee it should be changed from \$4.00 down to \$3.50. And again, all parties are agreed on this. So, therefore, I would recommend to the body that we go along with these recommendations on this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Johnson. You've heard the opening on AM3093 by Senator Johnson to LB 1099. Open for discussion on that motion. There are no lights on, Senator Johnson. Did you...he waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3093 to LB 1099. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is adoption of the Johnson amendment, AM3093. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.
