simply would raise a cap during that transition period. It's currently at 25 percent of the UNL tuition. It would raise that to 50 percent. It's intended to be a "transitionary" move, but I think it's one that is important and needs to happen. I will tell you that this is not cold, because there were...there was a bill introduced specifically to address this issue. It did have a public hearing. This would do less, actually, than what the bill called for. So I think it's well within the parameters, if you will, on that issue. So I got a note saying it's not on the machine, but if any of you have questions...it just came on. Okay. If any of you have any questions, I would sure try to address them. Senator Bourne may...I believe Senator Bourne is the one who introduced the bill, and he also is knowledgeable of the issue. So again, I ask your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Discussion on the Raikes amendment, FA1592? Senator Raikes, there are no lights on. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of FA1592, by Senator Raikes, to LB 1107. All in favor of the amendment vote aye, those opposed nay.
