making sure that the operations of the agency are nondiscriminatory, that in those cases the brokerage firm or the bank can receive the information on which they can base a decision about whether to enter into conciliation. They can also start working with the individual who has showed...who's demonstrated discriminatory practices and begin to change their...the way that they're operating immediately. And so it's very important for them to have this information. It's just a tweak in the law in that it makes it clear that the information is available through copies. Because we're limiting it to those cases where there's not a person that's aggrieved or a testing situation, then you're not going to have copies of information where an individual can use...could possibly use the information against another individual prior to the determination of whether there was an actual case of discrimination. So everybody is in agreement with this amendment and I would just ask for you to return the bill and to adopt the amendment, and then to advance the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brown. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion on the motion to return LB 625 to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator Brown, there are no lights on.
