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ever see a facility like that grow or be expanded to the level that they're going to see in other parts of the state. Is that because they're behind the curve? Is that because of poor management? I haven't been intimately involved in the discussions with the plant that's being proposed in my area or other parts of the state that some of you represent. It looks like what it is. But I wanted to offer the comments that I had before we got too far along on this. I know others may have comments as well but, Mr. President, I would withdraw my motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Further discussion on...Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President. I guess, as usual, I'm a day and a dollar short, because this would be one of the first times I'd have supported something that Senator Erdman wanted, and he's denied me that opportunity. So he can't say that I never offered. Would Senator Schrock yield to a question or two, please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you yield? Is Senator Schrock on the floor? Senator Schrock.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You had asked for an Attorney General Opinion regarding the legality of the deadline. Is that...?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I did.

SENATOR BOURNE: And when did you ask for that?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Oh, it's been about a week ago.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And I think we're close to getting one.

SENATOR BOURNE: Well, that's why I was going to support Senator Erdman's bracket motion. And I think he had it bracketed until March 30, which should be next week. There's still plenty of time. Go ahead, Senator.
