SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why? Why is that a problem? You're tied up April 16?

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Actually, I am, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, how about the 17th?

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: How about today?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, okay, we'll just chat with each other today. But that's all that I will take you for now, because you had something you were trying to do. Thank you. Members of the Legislature, Senator Cunningham is not in a position where he can accept any amendments. So we're going to discuss them. Senator Beutler will probably take his to a vote, and we will see how the body feels. But even if Senator Beutler's amendment is adopted, the bill remains punitive. The bill remains unfair. The business community prevailed on the state to lower the premiums they pay into this fund. And now the fruits of that unwise sowing are coming to fruition, and we can see how unwise that decision was. Now those forces were able to get a nice young senator named Cunningham to carry water for them. If he cannot see his way clear to agree to any amendments, then all we're going to do is chat. I really enjoy watching the back-and-forth between Senators Bourne and Loudon. The more Senator Loudon talks, the more he's putting himself in a position for me to write a poem making a play on his name. But I'm not going to tell him what it is. He's got to do a little bit more first, before I'm convinced that he's worthy of a rhyme.
