SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...when the one doing the pitching and tossing is a different person from yourself? There are bills that I don't like that are still on the agenda. So, Senator Friend, I mean it when I say I don't care if no other bill passes. I really don't care if not another bill passes. This bill was clotured once before. And shortly thereafter, numerous--I can use that term without exaggerating--senators came to me to ask me, what can we do to get past where we are now? And some who voted cloture told me--and you all know who you are--I shouldn't have done that. Well, maybe you've changed your mind and you think that was the right thing to do, and we have the opportunity now. But something should be done with this bill one way or the other, because it is a time taker. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bourne, you are the next speaker.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Madam President, members. Senator Friend, I totally can empathize with your comments. I think the first year that I was down here I...if I thought I could do it, I would have taken Senator Chambers outside. (Laugh) But I knew that that wasn't going to happen, so I just...I understand your frustration. I'm as opposed to this bill as anyone in here. The difference is, is that I think the will of the majority is the way democracy works, and I don't subscribe to Senator Chambers' slash and burn technique. But I guess what I'm saying is, I'm going to support the bracket motion. We'll see where we're at. And if Senator Cunningham can get the 30, or the 25 votes, or...against the bracket, or the...or he can get cloture, more power to him, and we go from there and then move on to the next bill.
