SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brown. Senator Brown, procedurally have to ask you to withdraw your motion to overrule the Chair first, if you care to do that.

SENATOR BROWN: Please withdraw the motion to overrule the Chair.

SPEAKER BROMM: And then...and it is withdrawn, and then AM3213, you wish to withdraw the amendment?

SENATOR BROWN: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment to the bill, legislative...I am sorry, Senator Louden, would offer AM3212.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Louden, you're recognized to open on your amendment

SENATOR LOUDEN: I'll withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Louden has asked to withdraw the amendment. It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would offer AM3376. (Legislative Journal page 1246.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: AM3376, Mr. Clerk?
