that again the body adopted, I think the city was enjoying the fruits of that new cigarette tax, and that they were able to build on their infrastructure. And I think you can make an analogous or comparable situation here, in that the city, the municipality itself, rather than the county, is enjoying the benefit. And again, this is...I think you can see my point. I'm trying...I would say it's from the municipality.

SENATOR LANDIS: Okay, I'll take my time back here. I'll tell you what, I think you raise a fair point. Difficulty is that we're dealing with a handwritten amendment. But let me tell you that if we were talking about private, public, local contributions, that would make a difference to me. If they were private and public from the city of Lincoln, it seems to me we could talk about what was reasonable here. I will say that there's a couple of things on my mind. What you changed was, you changed from "shall be transferred" to being available to being transferred. Big difference. I think what that means is, I think what you meant to say was, look, you don't get the money if the local subdivision doesn't pony up 10...a matching 10 percent. And if that's the goal and if we can take a look at a reasonable source of what those might be, meaning private, public, from Lincoln, city, county, whatever, I'll say that that's not an unreasonable idea that you're proposing. A difficulty is that we're doing it at 5:00 at night here, and we haven't done this. So you and I are doing it over the microphone. But if you're telling me as an idea, I think a local effort is legitimate. I think 10 percent is a fair figure. I think using public and private resources from the city of Lincoln or from Lancaster County would be a reasonable definition. But I also think that when that happens it needs to be...the money needs to be transferred, not available to be transferred. In other words, I think it's written in a way...it should be shall be transferred if the...and then whatever the local effort is...the locality in which the fair is provided matches at least 10 percent of the funds available for transfer from whatever is...you know, and a description of the public and private sources, or the city...
