doing it, that's the way this kind of language is structured. But I have something of more consequence on my mind also in line 5. I'm going to draft an amendment which says we would strike the period in line 5 and put language to the effect, and I'll get the language, except that no part of any such matching funds shall be provided by the state. If we're going to plunder the funds for the sake of the city of Lincoln forever, it shows how once "Emperor" Radcliffe gets busy he can wrap this Legislature around his little finger. And he'll be able to do the same thing if Lincoln hires him, and they will, or the State Fair hires him, and they will, or combined they will, to get the state to ante up the 10 percent. The city is supposed to come up with that money, but there is this second sentence which says, such matching funds may be obtained from the city and any other private or public entity. So either say the state, none of it shall be obtained from the state, or the term "entity" does not include the state. But I'd rather make it explicit language so that it's clear that this money is not coming from the state. I believe the state should be in a position to have access to this money generated from a lottery created for the state. It's a state lottery, and that money should not be taken off the table for Lincoln. Why do you think the Lincoln senators are working so hard? Because it's a Lincoln bill, despite what Senator Schimek insists on. And she does protest too much. She knows it's a Lincoln bill, but I'm not going to get caught up in that. I'd like to ask Senator Landis a question, because he is the point person on this whole thing.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Landis.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Landis, is it envisioned at this time that the state will be expected to come up with part or all of this 10 percent?

SENATOR LANDIS: No. It would...

SENATOR LANDIS: ...it would not be a local match, and I agree to the idea of a local match, if we were using state monies in that way. Remember that that could only happen with the state
