SENATOR BAKER: What we did is we got conflicting language in the bill. In one stage we have it...what you're referring to is driver's license. If you refer to the Final Reading copy on page 32, line 11, state identification card...and I...this is above it, furnishes two forms of proof identification in Section 60-484--that's that list of 30 or so proof forms of ID.

SENATOR BOURNE: Right.

SENATOR BAKER: And we're trying to rectify the language with the amendment that's actually in line 11 of page 32. It's there now.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR BAKER: Two forms of proof.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR BAKER: We're trying to harmonize this. Somehow or other, in this process of amending this bill, we got these things to where we only had one form of ID for an ID card.

SENATOR BOURNE: Right. Well, what I'm suggesting is we harmonize it the other way, because if we make the state ID card so hard to get that it's really useless as another form of identification,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...what have we accomplished?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may continue, Senator Bourne, your light is next.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Senator Baker, would you continue to yield?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you...

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I would.
