that you have my word that if between now and next session that we find that this requirement is creating a real problem for a large number of practitioners, that we will come back, I will be glad to revisit this issue next session. And as I have stated previously in the discussion of this bill that we are really plowing new ground and I expect that there will need to be some changes as if...and...as there are in many pieces of legislation when you are doing something new. So in summing, I believe that this requirement is a very minimum requirement for someone wishing to practice in this area of body art and that is why at this time I oppose the amendment and the motion to return to Select File. Thank you, and I give the rest of my time back to the Chair. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Senator Bourne, on the motion to return.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I'm not going to speak again. I'll take another 30 seconds. It simply allows an individual, who does not have a high school diploma or a GED, to be grandfathered in. And I told Senator Stuhr that I appreciate her willingness to work with us or anyone between now and April 1 of 2005 in the event that this has an overwhelmingly negative aspect on anybody, on any practitioner. But again, if you think that an individual who does not have a high school diploma should...and currently practices body art should be grandfathered in only as it relates to the high school education component, not to the test, I urge you to vote green on returning to Select File, and then the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing, the motion to return. Senator Bourne, did I recognize you to close? I say did I recognize you to close?

SENATOR BOURNE: That was my closing, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne was closing on his motion to return. All in favor of the motion to return LB 906 to Select File for specific amendment vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to return who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
