FLOOR DEBATE

March 25, 2004 LB 906A, 999

CLERK: (Read LB 906A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 906A pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1266-1267.) 35 ayes, 0 nays, 6 present not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 906A passes. (Visitors introduced.)

SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 999. Senator Quandahl, I had an amendment, AM3079. I understand you'd like to withdraw that amendment, Senator. Mr. President, Senator...excuse me, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Quandahl.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: That is correct.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Quandahl would move to return LB 999 to Select File for specific amendment, AM3404. (Legislative Journal page 1267.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Quandahl, you're recognized to open on your motion.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I'll try to make this as brief as possible. AM3404 basically removes AM2282, which we attached on Select File, which was an amendment that I had attached, and it was dealing with Section 1 of LB 999. That's the section that deals with...it's actually Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 8-113, that deals with the prohibition of the word "bank" by other institution. It removes quite a bit
