of the exceptions to that prohibition. But I would say that it does leave intact the provisions excepting from the use of the word "bank" nonprofit entities, 501(c)(3)'s, 501(c)(6)'s, which would include, or would allow, food banks, blood banks, to utilize the word "bank" in their name. I would say that the Department of Banking too has no current enforcement actions pending or even anticipated regarding this section. And so it is something that the Legislature can revisit in subsequent sessions. So I would urge you to vote for the return to Select File, and then later on for my amendment, AM3404.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. Any other persons wishing to address the motion? I see none. Senator Quandahl, you're recognized to close on your motion. He waives closing. The question before the body is whether LB 999E shall be returned to Select File for AM3404. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: The bill is returned. Senator Quandahl, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I believe I explained the amendment previously. I would just urge the adoption of AM3404.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.
