E & R for engrossing? All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 260, LR 261, LB 454, LB 963, LB 969, LB 906, and LB 906A (and LB 172). Mr. Clerk, do you have any items? At this time, we did move LB 139 to the bottom of the list, and so now we are ready to return to that. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, when the Legislature left the bill earlier today, Senator Chambers had pending FA1608, Senator, a motion to return for that specific amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Chambers, you're recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I withdraw that amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I had to the bill, Senator Brown, AM2930.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, I would withdraw.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, next amendment I had to the bill, Senator Brashear, AM...this was an earlier amendment filed. I believe Senator Brashear wanted to withdraw this amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: The next amendment I have is Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for a specific amendment, AM3408. (Legislative Journal page 1268.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your motion.
