SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay. Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the opening on AM3446, offered by Senator Wehrbein. Open for discussion on that amendment. Senator Wehrbein, there are no lights on. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3446 to LB 1089. All in favor of the amendment vote aye, those opposed nay. The question before the body is the Wehrbein amendment, AM3446, to LB 1089. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM3460. (Legislative Journal page 1376.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein, to open on AM3460.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President and members, this is a fairly small issue in the Electrical Board. They're having trouble with salaries, attracting enough salaries to attract the people to do their job, and we've had several meetings with this. Senator Schimek and I and others have had meetings on this, trying to resolve the problem, and what we have come up with is that they will request...the process is, by the way, if people want to change salary structures or categories, they have to go through the Personnel Board. Our committee waits on those every year to do that. Because the Electrical Board, which is cash funded, has had trouble attracting workers, at least to some degree, it may be subjective, but at least they would like to pay more but, based on the salary structure, they cannot. DAS has indicated that they want to submit a letter to try to make a special issue of that, or looking at those issues, and see if there's reason to do that. They can do that. And if they can
