It is good that he offered his amendment to raise the sales tax so that can be dispatched, but I don't know why he's going to throw the towel in so soon. We're going to talk about other things. Senator Brashear has something perched on the gadget, Senator Hartnett still has the income tax increase waiting in the wings, and we should discuss these things. I do not believe that time is being wasted by going through the kind of discussion that's occurring, because not only are senators trying to convince and persuade others, senators are telling themselves how they really feel about these matters. Nobody should be asked to make a decision as serious as the kind that is before us today on the spur of the moment, even if we had talked about this all day yesterday. That's not any great amount of time to spend on something as important as this.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now Congress a lot of times acts in a manner more "slipdash"...slapdash than appears in this Legislature, but they spend not only days and weeks, but sometimes months on a matter of this nature. I know much of it involves the President, involves political parties and others, but there is a tremendous amount of time involved. But we have let people get us to thinking as a Legislature that everything has to be done lickety-split, so we jump out there and run hastily into making bad decisions.
