we have to see them, in my mind, as a way to protect the shift to property tax. I would emphasize, property tax is going to be hurt if we do nothing. Mr. President, I would yield the rest of my time to Senator Beutler.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Kruse, thank you very much. I just wanted to indicate to you, because I will not have an opportunity to do so at the moment when it's done, the reason why I will withdraw this amendment at the very first opportunity, and refile it a couple of motions down. It is because a number of people have an interest in and have mentioned to me that there is still out there one viable nontax solution, and that is Senator Brashear's proposed solution to the problem. And so Senator Brashear is next on the list. I think it would make some sense to start voting things up or down, to deal with Senator Brashear's proposition one way or another. And then we will know we either have a nontax solution or we must choose from...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...a selection of tax solutions. So that's the reason that I will be doing that. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler and Senator Kruse. Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Question, please.
