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FLOOR DEBATE

April 1, 2004 LB 1090

SENATOR TYSON: Call of the house, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I did not hear you, Senator Tyson. You asked for a call of the house? A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized persons please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Janssen, Senator Bromm, Senator Jones, Senator Friend, Senator Schrock, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Stuhr, Senator Quandahl. Senator Baker, Senator Synowiecki, Senator Bourne, would you check in, please. Thank you. Senator Tyson, are you willing to accept call-in votes, or did you say so or not? Senator Tyson? A roll call vote has been requested when all members are present. Senator Stuhr, Senator Cunningham. Senator Cunningham, the house is under call. All members are present or accounted for. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on the question whether to cease debate.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1425.) 34 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Debate does cease. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on your motion to reconsider the vote taken on FA1647.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, what was achieved by that vote? I just like to give you things to meditate on. I'd like to ask Senator Janssen a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen.
