SENATOR CUDABACK: Members, please check in. We are under call. Mr. Clerk, read the question before the body.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to reconsider the vote taken on the Chambers amendment, specifically FA1647 to the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Members, please check in. We are under call. Every member should be here. Please check in, Senator Bourne, Senator Loudon. Roll call has been requested on the question before the body. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.

2 ayes, 34 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to reconsider was not successful, and I do raise the call. Senator Beutler, you're recognized.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, I'd withdraw the amendment.
