Twenty-two years: We've got Senator Nelson, we've got Senator Scofield, we've got Governor Orr, we've got 1988, we've got people running around, I don't even know who they are. Senator Schellpeper, I've heard that name obviously. Nebraska Right To Vote Committee; we've got Senator Dierks. We all know and love him. We've got...we've got Boyd County withdrawing their consideration in 19...withdraws from consideration in 1989. They wanted out of this in 1989. What I'm getting at is, and the point to this whole thing is, we're trying to solve something, as far as I'm concerned, in two years, which isn't solvable right now. We need to figure this thing out. We need to lay it out, and there are a lot of steps yet before this chess match is over. If we jump into it and try to trap that queen down in the corner, or a rook or whatever we're going after, we ain't gonna get it. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Friend. Senator Chambers, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, if it seems that there's a consensus to do nothing then I think LB 1093 ought to be killed. LB 1093, which is two places down, ought to be killed. Then...let me ask Senator Raikes a question.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Raikes, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Raikes is the number cruncher and he was officially dubbed the "Befuddler," you know, like the Riddler in Bat Man. I would like to ask the "Befuddler" a question so that some of us can cease to be befuddled. Senator Raikes, if LB 1093 is killed, what will happen?

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator, there are two parts of the state aid formula that LB 1093 extends into the upcoming biennium that would not be extended into the upcoming biennium, and one of those is moving the school levy lid from \$1 to \$1.05, and another one is a...what's called the temporary aid adjustment.
