portion of the amendment that is the income tax portion that will be up on everybody's gadget shortly.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. Thank you, Senator Schimek. This portion, which is the income tax, is at 5.7 percent, and we're looking at a total on that for the year of \$51 million from this. So theoretically, and if we keep on going the way we have...the way we have it divided now, and I'm sure that you all understand what is going to transpire here, that Senator Chambers on the next division will take out the sales tax portion. That is his primary objective. So...and if we...we have already let the surcharge go so, instead of being able to do this in one year, it's going to take us three years to get up to the...close to where the judgment will be. So I just want you to be aware of that. I don't believe that it is that harmful or subjective to anyone, this small of increase in the income tax, so...but that's for you to decide. You know, if you feel as though that it is, then, you know, we'll go back to square one again. We won't do anything. But I believe it...I don't believe it is up to the point where we were in 1997, if my recollection is right, so this would be only for a year. That's the way the bill reads, and then we'd have to come back and address it again. So for your consideration; we've heard all the arguments on all three parts of this amendment anyway, and I believe that we need to start putting some seed money back somewhere. I don't like to do this, but I feel as we've got ourselves boxed into a corner here and we should start making some provisions to address the situation that we're going to be in sooner or later. So with that, that's where I'm at.
