SENATOR BOURNE:    And it's \$51 million on an annual basis.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Correct.

SENATOR BOURNE:    So can you tell us how much money will be put into the Judgment Fund? And we heard Senator Brashear talk. He kind of seemed...he seemed to think that that judgment, worst case scenario, could be due November 1 of this year.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Uh-huh.

SENATOR BOURNE:    Again, do you know how much money this tax increase would generate between the time it becomes effective and, say, November 1 of this year?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Oh, about three.    About zero.    It would be zero.

SENATOR BOURNE:    So, Senator Janssen, so you're asking us to raise income tax and yet it won't provide any money whatsoever to the Judgment Fund when the fund comes due?

SENATOR JANSSEN:    That's right.    But it's a start, Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE:    I cannot disagree.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    You got to start somewhere.

SENATOR BOURNE:    Absolutely, I absolutely agree.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    You can't finish a race unless you start it.

SENATOR BOURNE:    (Laugh)    Absolutely.    Thank you, Senator Janssen.    Thank you very much.

SENATOR JANSSEN:    Sure.

SENATOR BOURNE:    I...I'm not trying to be critical.    I'm just trying to illustrate that, again, if we're going to raise
