Does that ring a bell?

SENATOR TYSON: No, I don't think I used the word "comic relief."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR TYSON: I normally say that for you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Madam President, when we get the transcript, I'm going to show Senator Tyson that I pay more attention to what he says than he does when he says it. I've already shown that I pay more attention to Senator Janssen. Now, I'm aware that it's difficult to follow everything that everybody says during the day, but if you have a reason to pay attention, you can and you will. Senator Redfield may have expressed the frustration of some of our colleagues. Some of them may have supported Senator Beutler's proposal, but he knew there were not enough votes here to have it adopted. Senator Brashear knew his proposal was not going to be adopted. But I take them all seriously and I debated them as though they were as seriously offered as I was serious in dealing with them, and that's the way I will consider matters before us. But when Senator Beutler offered an amendment that would have stricken his proposal from what Senator Janssen is offering, there was no need for me to say anything because I do disagree with his proposal. But I didn't...I don't recall having heard anybody speak against Senator Beutler's proposal being removed from what Senator Janssen is offering us. So the only negative reaction I saw to what Senator Beutler was asking, four red lights on the board. Those could have just been protest votes. But since nobody said anything, there's no way to determine for sure what those votes meant except that they would not want Senator Beutler to have removed his portion of what Senator Janssen is offering us. I think the sales tax portion should have been taken first--get everything out of the way except the income tax.
