SENATOR BEUTLER: Call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: There's been a request for a call of the house and a roll call vote. Would all members please return...all in favor please vote aye. All in favor of a call of the house please vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Will all members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Jensen, would you check in, please. Senator Bromm, Senator Schrock, Senator Cudaback, Senator Quandahl, Senator Thompson, would you please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Mr. Clerk, would you call the roll, please. Oh, we're not? Senator Cunningham, would you please return. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1434.) 21 ayes, 19 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is not adopted. Next item. Oh, I raise the call.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Janssen would move to amend with FA1655, which includes Sections 2 and Section 4 of his original amendment. I think, Senator, these are the components that deal with sales tax. (Legislative Journal pages 1434-1435.)
