Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion has...was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Senator Jensen would move to amend with AM3291. (Legislative Journal page 1186.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on AM3291 to LB 1091.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This just changes the date from 2004 to 2005. It was incorrectly, actually, in the amendment to make it 2004; 2005 is the right date. I'd just ask for its adoption. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Open for discussion on the motion. There are no senators...thank you, Senator Jensen. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3291, offered by Senator Jensen to LB 1091. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the Jensen amendment, AM3291, to LB 1091. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Raikes would move to amend, AM3480. (Legislative Journal page 1407.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, you're recognized to open on your amendment, AM3480.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Let me remind you quickly of a discussion we had on General File on this bill, which dealt with use of some of the...I'll say education share of the lottery money that is proposed to go to the General Fund in the out biennium, diverting that, or using it, I guess maybe I'd prefer that use of the term, using it
