SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, would you respond?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Maybe to follow up a question of Senator Bromm, if both schools were over 390, that were going to get together, they would not get any of these funds. Is that correct?

SENATOR RAIKES: That's correct. That's correct.

SENATOR HARTNETT: So what you're really...if I look at this one chart that you passed out, you're...what you're really, really trying to do is to take, because as I look at the chart, if I'm back at the school with 75, I think is the smallest one, is that correct, if...

SENATOR RAIKES: It's 78, I believe, was on this.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Seventy-eight.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yeah.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Then they would get some place between \$3,000 per student, is that correct, or what?

SENATOR RAIKES: Well, actually the incentive payment is depicted on the back of that chart, and the...well, it kind of is, I guess, and kind of...yes, you're right. I think about \$3,400 is the way that would work out.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Per student.

SENATOR RAIKES: Per student, for that 78-student school. So if the 78-student school merged with one that had, say, 500, then the total incentive to that reorganized system would be 78 times \$3,400.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay.
