SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR JONES: Yes, you spoke about having 15 per class and for 13 classes to get your number 390.

SENATOR RAIKES: You have to multiply that at two in there I think.

SENATOR JONES: That comes up to 195. And you have to take 30 times 13 to get 390. Am I right?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yeah, you're ahead of me, but I think you're right.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SENATOR RAIKES: Two classes of fifteen students times thirteen grades.

SENATOR JONES: You take 2 classes times 13.

SENATOR RAIKES: Two, yes, so you'd have two...in each grade you'd have two sections of 15 students, and which we talked about is sort of on the low end of the ideal student-teacher or class size for elementary grades.

SENATOR JONES: Sure, that's right and, yeah, I understand that now because I was only figuring one class. Okay. Next question is, is this going to be going out on a calendar year, or is it going to go out on a school year? I mean, I know they start the school year, you know, first of September or August sometimes. Would it be for two years starting then, or how is it...how is it set up?

SENATOR RAIKES: Senator, it would pretty much correspond to school years.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yeah.
