SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. In a sense I foresaw this coming on a Friday afternoon when people are impatient to move on through things, so with conversation with Senator Chambers, we agreed to cut it in half which, to me, is better than nothing. And we do preclude an afternoon of haranguing on Friday afternoon. And so I accept the offer to go to half, \$153,000 is better than nothing. It is going to help young people just about exclusive my understanding in terms of the premiums and it does cover a broad gamut. I hope we don't have to discover...discuss the issue in great detail. We do have some other work to do and I would prefer to get to that. So I hope the rest of the body will accept this agreement that we've gotten. For those of you that are not so supportive of the State Fair, it is less than it would have been at \$306,000. And for those of us that want to support the State Fair, it is more than zero, and I urge you to support both the return and the advancement of the bill as amended. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers, did you wish to use any more of your opening? If not, you may close if you care to. He waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 1089 be returned to Select File for specific amendment? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The motion before the body is to return LB 1089 to Select File for a specific amendment. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion was successful. LB 1089 has been returned. Mr. Clerk.
