SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, would you respond?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Erdman, did you say that you and Senator Schimek cosponsored that amendment?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I thought I heard that, and when I told Senator Brown I was floored, I said either it's a very good amendment or neither one of them understands what the amendment does. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, Senator Schrock, if I could just have a short exchange with you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR BEUTLER: You've deleted from the bill the whole section dealing with mediation that applies on certain sections, isn't that correct?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That is correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: When we were discussing this bill on General File, you were resisting all amendments on the theory that this was a very delicately held-together matter and no amendments would do; we couldn't change the fees because nobody would like that. When I asked you about NRDs, you couldn't change that but we'll do it next year. This was a huge section on mediation. Why was it changed, Senator?

SENATOR SCHROCK: To accommodate the concerns of Senator Chambers, and we also recognized, and after we talked about this
