SENATOR SCHROCK: That is correct, and you and I had that conversation off the floor on one person, one vote, and there is some delicate issues there that I think we can wait to address because it would upset the balance in some cases. But we also know, for the body's information, that at least 80 to 85 percent of the NRDs at the current time are real close to one person, one vote. That means they are within 1.2 to 1. And so I think we're real close on most NRDs right now.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Well, I just wanted to serve notice, Senator, that I'm taking that thing...that part of it real seriously and I consider it related to all water matters, just the same as a fee issue. And I hope that we can make some progress on those issues in the near future.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And I take that issue seriously also, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you for the time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock, seeing no further lights on, you're recognized to close on AM3366. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM3366 offered by Senator Schrock to LB 962. All in favor of the motion vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.
