this is still your opening. Did you wish to use your minute?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Just briefly, Mr. President, thank you. I do
support Senator Beutler's amendment. We...there was a...some
discussion about that word, whether it should be "may" or
"shall," and we will revert back to "may." Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. We're discussing
AM3398. There are no lights on. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. I again would
encourage your support of AM3398. And, again, I will support
the amendment that Senator Beutler has drafted and I appreciate
the work that has been done on this legislation. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You've heard the
closing on AM3398. The question before the body is, shall that
amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
Record please, Mr. Clerk.
