April 2, 2004 LB 1084A

SENATOR ERDMAN: Just briefly, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, there is also a savings that's going to be incurred. There is a deterrent savings, if you will, in the idea that we're going to be prosecuting or have the ability to prosecute. There is going to be a deterrent effect that could show up as savings, and that's part of the discussion that we've been having as far as the fiscal note. But, again, I would encourage your adoption or advancement of LB 1084A so that we can implement the provisions of LB 1084. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You heard the closing on advancement of LB 1084A. All in favor of the advancement vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 1084A. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1084A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. LB 1084A does advance. Speaker Bromm, did you wish to be recognized? If so, you are.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Just want to tell the body a couple of things. Since the agenda isn't out yet, so you could anticipate and plan a little bit for Monday, I think we'll go ahead and start with LB 391, which would be the next bill, the age of majority bill. And we will follow that with LB 1065, the ethanol bill, and the rest of the agenda will be printed. You did what needed to be done this week. I want you to know that. You advanced every major budget bill in position for Final Reading. Those bills won't be read until some time middle or latter part of next week on Final Reading. But Monday evening is scheduled as a late night and we'll do...we've got a number of bills, more than 50 I think, and Monday night, starting I think at six o'clock, we'll do about two hours of Final Reading. So we'll use our late night Monday night, at least part of it, for that. So with that, I thank you for another great week of good work and I wish you the best for the weekend. Thank you.
