SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd...that would be helpful, I think. Thank you. Let me ask you one last question. The Chair of the Appropriations Committee is interested in this bill because of the \$3.9 million savings. And I'm sure he has a broader interest than that, but I'm just identifying that.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Time has expired.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Can you identify the sections for us that...?

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Time has expired, Senator. Sorry. Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, over the weekend I went through this entire amendment. I don't know how Senator Jensen's committee would have handled reducing payments to wards with special needs disabilities. Reducing the age from 19 to 18 has consequences. If there is a spouse of an...who is a widow or widower, where an officer is concerned, the age of the child for the purposes of benefits will be reduced. It talks about the definition of a dependent child. And I suppose that would...well, I don't know whether that would go to tax and every other provision of law where the term "dependent child" is used. It goes into the Parenting Act. We talk about what will be available for the dependent of a deceased employee. And I guess you save money by reducing the age of the dependent child who could receive that. There are reductions in cash assistance to recipients by reducing the age of the children involved. The real estate license, a real estate appraiser's license, certified residential real estate appraiser's license, general real estate appraiser's license. These are not matters that would come before the Judiciary Committee. I think real estate issues go to some other committee. A broker's and salesperson's license, the age would be reduced to 18. To get a polygraph license. I don't know that the Judiciary Committee has ever dealt with polygraph licensure, but that, voice stress licensure, acupuncture licenses, massage therapy licenses, when a hospital patient can give authorization for visits, and on and on and on. I went through each section. And when I asked for that division, by the way, I knew the division wouldn't occur while we are dealing
