"closing the door" in the committee, meaning we wanted to make sure there was an end to the application process and qualification process so that we could find a funding mechanism equal to the number of potential claimants that we had. These two amendments do portions of that. One part says there are no new applications for ethanol benefits after the effective date of the act. That's the "door closing." The second one says it provides for LB 775 and the Invest Nebraska applications received on or after the effective date of this act won't get LB 775 credits if they get production credits. That means after the effective date you don't get the LB 775 and production credits, closing the door.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Members of the Legislature, there will be plenty of opportunities that I will have to go after the bill after the committee amendment, as amended, is adopted. But...and I can still go after some of the provisions that I am in the existing law as it exists in the committee amendment, but I do think if this bill winds up being passed, the only thing that could justify it, in my mind, would be language that does what Senator Landis described. I was aware of that and it was why I said I...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...would not try to strike any of the underlined material from the committee amendment as I'm utilizing time. But in order that the committee and those who worked to get this amendment in the shape that it's in will not feel their work is in vain or to get the impression that I cannot appreciate work of this kind, I will continue my battle against the bill after the committee amendment is adopted. But I would like to ask Senator Baker a question if he's anywhere near.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you respond?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, would you agree to accept this amendment if I don't offer any more amendments on the committee
