SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We need to take that gas tax out of this bill. And I believe we're going to do it sooner or later. "Sooner" has passed, so we've got to do it "later." And my responsibility is to see that we stay here until "later" arrives. And when the proper moment comes, we will be like a wise farrier. We know when the iron has reached the proper temperature, so that if we strike it, or if we're working with steel, we know how to manage that steel. Some of us know how to manage things on the floor of the Legislature, and we haven't reached the point yet where we can shape the steel to do anything of value with it. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Baker, on...there he is. Senator Baker, on the indefinite postpone motion.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. No, I wasn't sneaking in to eat, Senator Chambers. I'm not leaving this place with your IPP motion on the board. No, I'm not about to leave this place. They're going to bring me food in, though, as I understand it. Smells good. But no, I have to continue to oppose the IPP motion. That is not an option, folks. There are very few people in here, because I...we are going to Final Reading. I think everybody is trying to eat before that. And I'm going to get left out, along with a couple others. Senator Chambers I guess doesn't need any food. But it smells kind of good, even though he may not eat it. It smells kind of good in there, but I'm not going to leave the floor.
