April 5, 2004 LB 155, 869, 1047

All in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1478.)
39 ayes, 3 nays, 3 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 869 passes. Next bill, LB 1047. The first vote will be to suspend the at-large reading, according to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting to dispense with the at-large reading. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The at-large reading is dispensed with. Mr. Clerk, read the title, please.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 1047.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1047 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1479.)
45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1047 passes. Mr. Clerk...Madam Clerk, LB 155.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 155 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 155 pass? All in favor of the motion vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1480.)
44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
