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FLOOR DEBATE

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LB 983, 1065

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I think Senator Landis just informed me he didn't want to listen to me for five minutes closing. Is that correct, Senator Landis? I get two. I'm not going to take that long. I'm disappointed with where we are with the funding gap in this whole process now but I'm willing to work on it and...between now and Select File, and I think it's obviously time to move on. I would ask for your vote to advance LB 1065 to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing on advancement of LB 1065. The question before the body is, shall LB 1065 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye; those opposed nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 1065 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1065.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. LB 1065 does advance. We now go to Select File, 2004 Speaker priority bills. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK: LB 983. Senator Mossey, I have Enrollment and Review amendments. (AM7223, Legislative Journal page 1280.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 983.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion by Senator Mossey to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 983. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 983 to E & R for engrossing.
