CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Unexcused members please return to the Chamber. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Dwite Pedersen, Senator Schrock, Senator Quandahl, Senator Cunningham, Senator Synowiecki, Senator Thompson, would you please check in? Senators Dwite Pedersen, Schrock, Cunningham, and Synowiecki, if you'd please return to the Chamber. All members are present. Again, for those who weren't here, this is a vote to invoke closure. If closure is successful, then we'll proceed to vote on the underlying amendments and the advancement of the bill. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone malfunction)...order, Mr. Speaker

SPEAKER BROMM: I'm sorry, roll call vote in...

SENATOR LANDIS: Regular order.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...regular order has been requested. Okay, members, the question before us then is whether closure shall be invoked at this time on LR 209CA. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1500.) 37 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is successful. We'll then proceed to vote on FA1606 to AM3396. All in favor of amendment FA1606 please vote aye, and opposed nay. A roll call vote has been requested...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction)...in reverse order.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...in reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1500-1501.) 41 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.
