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SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Here's the question I want to get an answer to. Has there been opposition to this amendment?

SENATOR BYARS:        I don't know of any opposition to this amendment, Senator, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    I've received opposition. Is there anything in here that would grandfather in those people who already are counselors?

SENATOR BYARS:        Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Where would that be found and what does it say? And I see help is on the way.

SENATOR BYARS:        It automatically licenses all current CADACs and provisional CADACs in their respective categories upon the operative date of the act. Now where that is I would have to look to see in the amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    That's all right. That's okay, because I wanted to hear what the language was. Now I'd like to ask Senator Dwite Pedersen a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Would you yield, Senator Pedersen?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN:    Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Senator Dwite Pedersen, how long did you say you had been a cicada?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN:    A CADAC, 22 years.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Not a cicada?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN:    I don't know what a cicada is.  
(Laughter)

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    But as far as you know, you are not now or ever have been a cicada.
