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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Johnson, did you tell Senator Dwite Pedersen that a cicada is a locust?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you ever seen a locust?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Well, I think, if I recall correctly, a locust is a more general term, is it not? And...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you seen a locust of your own personal knowledge?

SENATOR JOHNSON: I'm quite sure I have.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does a locust look like a grasshopper?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Somewhat, and I...and I can't...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If you put a grasshopper and a locust side-by-side, could you tell which...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...one was a locust and which is a grasshopper?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you ever seen a cicada?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And a cicada looks like a grasshopper to you?

SENATOR JOHNSON: No, not...not exactly, by quite a bit really.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, why did you tell Senator Dwite Pedersen that a cicada is a locust?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Because it's an interchangeable word, I
