SENATOR BYARS: I would not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to say "public members"?

SENATOR BYARS: I would not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If you were addressing a group of your constituents and they're not knowledgeable about legislative idiocies, and you were talking about the makeup of a committee, would you mention the professional people by their designation and say there are also two members of the public, or would you say two public members?

SENATOR BYARS: I'm not sure. Probably...I'm not positive about that, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there anything in here which says professional members? How does it...give me a description that is in the bill of any other person or category who will be on this commission.

SENATOR BYARS: If you look at the...if you look at the language, you will see that it's spelled out on the Board of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Council, six alcohol and drug counselors, three of whom may be licensed as psychologists or mental health practitioners, and three of whom are not licensed as psychologists or mental health practitioners, but one person who is a psychiatrist, psychologist, or mental health practitioner, and two public members, and then provides for the terms of those appointments. As I read...as I read this, actually, Senator, and counsel might correct me on this, but it would appear to me that you could have more than two public members, or members of the public,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BYARS: ...on this committee.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not talking about the numbers. I'm
