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get into money and I know that money is going to be difficult and I know that it will probably always be with us, but I'm more interested in the follow-up. And I'm not totally satisfied with the response that you had, not that I don't think you had a good response, but I'd like to take it a little bit further and I'd like to take us to the year 2007 when most of us won't still be here, certainly not in 2009. None of us, almost, will be here. And I'm wondering if there isn't some kind of provision or if there aren't some kinds of prescriptions for reporting written into the bill itself, are we going to...are we going to get or are future Legislatures going to get what we need to make certain that things are going as they should? Will we know in the year 2006 what the waiting lists are? Will we know in the 2008 what the waiting lists are? I guess I'm certain that you probably imagine that this oversight committee will maybe mandate some of that, but when it all gets down to the very nub of it, it is the Legislature that has the final responsibility, and I'm just...I'm just kind of asking right now and thinking that there ought to be something more, if not written into this bill then written into another bill next year perhaps.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, would you respond?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, I will. And thank you, Senator Schimek. The Oversight Commission stays into effect till 2008, so we got it covered to 2007. At 2008, it will sunset unless, you know, by the Legislature at that time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: But what interaction is there with us?

SENATOR JENSEN: Monthly reporting...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...to the Health and Human Services and to the Legislature. So we'll have a very good idea how that is working. And along with that, there is in the bill also a data collection piece that HHS will participate in. So I think that we'll have the data, we'll have the reporting. We're going to have a very good idea how this is proceeding. Now what a future Legislature might do, and we had an earlier conversation earlier
