CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Senator Baker, Mr. President, would offer AM3483. Senator, I have a note you want to withdraw?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Byars would move to amend, AM3591. (Legislative Journal page 1515.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on your amendment, AM3591.

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Mr. President. With the adoption of AM3443, the Legislative Fiscal Office has said that we need to change the cash funds, which the credentialing fees are put into and the appropriations taken out of, so it's just a matter of switching from one fund to the other. All of the funds are cash funded. There's no General Fund dollars involved. And I would ask that you would adopt AM3591 to LB 1083A.
