SENATOR SMITH: Well, what I would reference is once a year, but that's irrelevant to this bill because this bill only allows one event per year that is less than two days.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. So it would only...actually it is we are singling out one, one specific function during the year in your case.

SENATOR SMITH: Right, but it would have to be less than two days.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Uh-huh. Yeah, visiting with you after General File, I think what...what's happening in your area is probably a worthwhile thing. It seems to me like it is a good crowd raiser and a lot of people come and patronize these local stands. Is that correct?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: And the street is full of people and full of vendors, right?

SENATOR SMITH: That's correct.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. So, as far as you know, there is someone there in Department of Agriculture that is checking on those licenses.

SENATOR SMITH: Right.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. Thank you, Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: That answers some of my questions. As you know, I am in the food business also, and we are under periodic inspection; have to follow the guidelines very carefully so that we don't make anyone sick.
