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SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I would like to enter into a little bit a discussion with Senator Landis.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, would you yield to a question from Senator Stuthman?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'll do my best.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: On...in Section 4, it states, "Construction services means annexing building materials to real estate, repair of real estate." Okay, now the definition there, the repair of real estate, does that mean I've got a dam that has gone out, soil conservation dam, terraces are broke out, I need to get those repaired. My heavy equipment operators, will they be taxed on the labor portion of that?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: No.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: No.

SENATOR LANDIS: Land...yeah, land-moving services aren't there in that kind of a situation, no.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: But land is real estate, isn't it?

SENATOR LANDIS: The piece that you're interested in knowing about will be in the following amendment, Arnie. When we finally get to what we want,...

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...and then we're going to suggest to the body that will not be taxed, but you can see it in the following amendment. I'll see if I can show you the language there.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay, that was the concern that I had that, you know, in reading where we're discussing right now, you know, it is a repair of the real estate portion, and I wanted to get
