It makes the administration possible so that those who do want to participate and pay taxes can figure out how they're supposed to do that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. It is 5:45. As the agenda states, General File, 2004 committee priority bill. Speaker Bromm, you're recognized.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. There's been an interest expressed by the sponsor of the bill to withdraw...to vote on just the pending amendment, to withdraw any other amendment. I think the other amendment pending he's willing to withdraw, and so if we can do that and take up the amendments on Select File, we could take five minutes and do this and then finish up what we were going to do at 5:45. So we'll modify the agenda to try to finish this. If that doesn't happen in five minutes, we'll have to leave the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Senator Landis, to close on AM3586.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. These were the amendments they told, where I will withdraw the bright line amendment, explain it on Select File. There are differences of opinion. Senator Combs thinks the number should be 25 percent. "Emperor" Radcliffe thinks that it should be 35 percent. The right number is actually 40 percent and I'll make that case to you on Select File. My guess is we want the contractor labor issue cleared up and now is the time to act. I ask for the adoption of this amendment, the advancement of the bill, and taking it up on Select File.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on AM3586. The question before the body is, shall AM3586 be adopted to the Revenue Committee amendments to LB 1017? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of AM3586. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of the Landis amendment to the committee amendments.
