The question before the body is, shall AM3491 be adopted to LB 499? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is adoption of AM3491. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. AM3491 has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill as amended, advancement to E & R Initial. Senator Hartnett, your light is on. Did you wish to be...

SENATOR HARTNETT: I would just simply thank Senator Bromm, the Speaker, for bringing this up because I think it's very, very important to companies in this state, that we treat them as we did treat them before the passage of gas bill last year. So I'd ask for the advancement of this, of LB 499.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I didn't ask if anybody wanted to debate the issue. Seeing no lights on, we'll take that as a closing, Senator Hartnett. The question before the body is, shall LB 499 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of advancement vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is, shall LB 499 advance?
