SPEAKER BROMM: LB 1071 does pass. LB 1089E. Members, the first vote on LB 1089E will be a vote to dispense with the Final Reading. All those in favor of dispensing with the Final Reading on LB 1089E, please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 41 ayes, 2 nays, on the motion to dispense with the at-large reading, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The at-large reading is dispensed with Madam Clerk, please read LB 1089E with the emergency clause attached by title.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 1089.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1089E pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1537.) The vote is 39 ayes, 7 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 1089 does pass with the emergency clause. LB 1090E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have with respect to LB 1090 is from Senator Brashear. Senator Brashear would move to return LB 1090 to Select File to strike the enacting clause.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on your motion.
