advise the body of how we would envision this process, at least initially, taking place. Pursuant to the major proposal Rule 1, 17(c), it would be my I guess order of amendments and motions to first of all take up a motion to advance LR 11CA to Final Reading. Then there are some amendments and I have met with those who have filed amendments and asked them each to indicate what amendment they would like to consider, and pursuant to that discussion and time permitting I would say that first of all we'll take up Senator Janssen's AM3572. It would be the plan to follow that with the Smith amendment, AM3602. And if we...if time permits, we go to Senator Aguilar's AM3601 and then Senator Louden's AM3598. Now I would reserve, certainly under the rule and as a matter of I think proper reasonable procedure, I'd reserve the right to change that order at some point in time if it appears that that's an appropriate thing to do, but I just wanted to lay out kind of what the thinking was at this point, after meeting with both the primary sponsor of this bill and also those who would like to amend it or oppose it. So that's the process and I would ask the president, presiding officer, to allow Senator Janssen to bring us up-to-date on the bill since it's been some time since it's been on the floor. Thank you.
