SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, there's been six people. That's about the guideline that we use normally, outside of a case where there hasn't been debate prior to. So I will rule that there has been full and fair debate, let the body decide. The question is, shall debate cease on the readvancement of LR 11CA? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on ceasing debate on the readvancement of LR 11CA. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Voting on the readvancement of LR 11CA...on ceasing debate, excuse me, my error; ceasing debate on the readvancing of LR 11CA. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion was successful. Debate does cease. Senator Janssen, to close.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I believe that you can see what the will of the body is. We have spent a lot of time on this over the last two years. I did designate this as a priority bill and it did fall in line with the rest of the priority bills that were asked for this year. I don't believe I'm out of line. Each senator has the right to designate a priority bill at the beginning of the year. That means every one of us. So I would ask for readvancement to Final Reading. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Point of order, Mr. President. I am unfamiliar with...
